

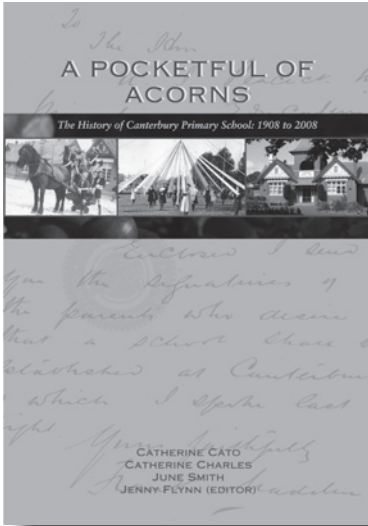

'A Pocketful of Acorns' thoughtfully unfolds reflections from past and present students to help reveal a rich and varied past.

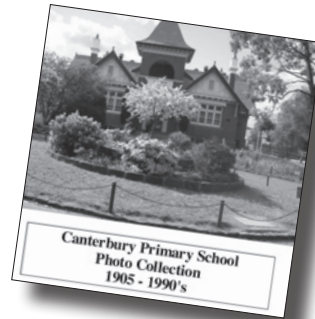
