

## Can you help bake for the Canvas Café? Baker's Information Sheet

The Canvas Café offers a relaxing place for our visitors (and us) to sit back, have a chat and enjoy a bite to eat over Saturday and Sunday. The café sells sweet and savoury items, and hot and cold drinks. The following information may be useful if you are interested in baking for the Café.

### 1. The café is very popular

The café has many visitors over the weekend and to cater for this we need lots of items such as cakes, biscuits and scones (recipe available) to sell. We rely on the school community to help bake so if you are able to make more than one item or a double batch it really helps. Even consider if a friend, grandparent or older child would like to bake something too. We generally sell everything we receive, so all help is needed.

### 2. Pumpkin soup is also sold.

If you would be able to make pumpkin soup we have tried and tested recipe. If you (or someone you know) could help out with making soup, please sign up (information below) or contact Kathryn (details below).

### 3. Special dietary requirements are catered for.

There is a growing demand for gluten free items, as well as other special items such as dairy free and egg free. If you are able to bake special dietary items it would also be greatly appreciated. Please include a note with your goods if they meet a particular special dietary requirement.



### 4. Food safety and labeling.

In order to comply with Council Regulations we need an ingredients listing for each product. We provide two stickers on which we ask you to write the ingredients you used. Please include these stickers with your goods when you drop them off. We put one sticker into our Council Records and attach the other one to the display card for the weekend.

### 5. How to volunteer.

### 6. Containers and plates.

Please deliver your items in sealed plastic containers as it helps us to store them correctly. If you have display platters or cake plates with domes, that you would be willing to loan, please let us know. This all helps to make our café look even better. Don't forget to label everything, and please collect your items on Monday after the art exhibition.

### 7. Dropping off items.

We will be using the staff room to receive items. To coincide with school drop off and pick up we plan to receive goods at the following times although if it's easier you can arrange to come in at other times.
